Mayor Cury opened the meeting.

The Invocation and Pledge was led by Mayor Cury.

Mayor Cury advised the Public Hearing is for the purpose of receiving public input on local community development and business revitalization in relation to Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding for a downtown revitalization project in the community.

Mayor Cury advised the meeting was open to take public comment.

Jordan Dillon, Economic Development Director for the Cumberland Plateau Planning District spoke to the Council about the CDBG Grant and advised they would be focusing on the Business District.

Mrs. Dillon advised her, and Susan Whitt have a date set to walk to businesses and talk with them.

Mr. White inquired what the date of implementation would be, and Mrs. Dillon advised they are working through the preliminary right now.

Mrs. Dillon mentioned that she would need to amend the project scope due to new DHCD requirements for installing flood resilient windows and doors in the downtown revitalization area as part of the façade improvements and also to include a business in the nearby area that had asked to be included.
