Mayor Cury opened the meeting.


The Invocation and Pledge was led by Jan White.

Mayor Cury advised the Public Hearing is for the purpose of receiving public comment and to consider the adoption of a proposed resolution authorizing the issuance by the Town of a water and wastewater revenue bond in the aggregate maximum amount not to exceed \$8,181,452, in one or more series (the “Bond”). The Town would use the proceeds of the Bond, together with other funds lawfully available to the Town, to acquire, construct, rehabilitate, and equip the Town’s wastewater system and related facilities, including but not limited to wastewater treatment plant rehabilitation, and (b) pay costs in connection with issuing the related bond (collectively, the “Project”).


Mayor Cury advised the meeting was open to take public comment.
