Mayor Cury advised the meeting was open to take public comment.

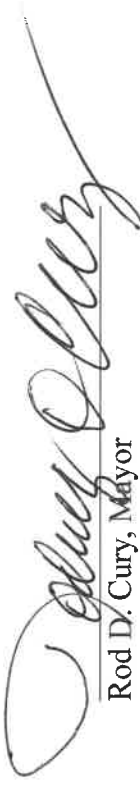
Ernest Edgil, 2026 Terry Drive-
